Here's what's being highlighted on top food bloggers' homepages right now, based on the data. Breakfast, salad, and soup recipes are everywhere, each showing up more often than dessert or even dinner. It's a reminder that lighter, everyday meals are getting more attention than elaborate or indulgent ones.

Spring is clearly in the spotlight too, with seasonal tags on the rise and baked dishes appearing far more often than grilled, no-bake, or slow cooker recipes. Easter is the most-tagged holiday, which makes sense with it falling this week. A scroll through homepages confirms it: lots of brunches, mains, and pastel-hued sweets.

Vegan and vegetarian tags are still leading the way over keto and gluten-free, which may point to a broader interest in plant-based meals right now. It's interesting to see which trends hold steady, which ones fade, and how much of what we see is shaped by what's in season.
